



In collaboration with the parent or guardian of the student, the following program techniques will be available for students with special needs or developmental disabilities.

1. Specialized Instruction (Without Formal IEP)

- **Description:** Customized teaching methods tailored to each child's abilities without the formality of an IEP.
- **Services Provided:** Teachers use adaptive techniques such as visual aids, hands-on learning, and scaffolding strategies to support students with diverse needs.

2. Speech and Language Therapy

- **Description:** Direct support to improve communication skills without the need for an IEP.
- **Services Provided:** One-on-one or group therapy sessions that focus on enhancing language development, pronunciation, and effective communication.

3. Occupational Therapy

- **Description:** Support for fine motor skills, sensory processing, and daily living activities.
- **Services Provided:** Exercises and activities to improve hand-eye coordination, sensory regulation, and self-help skills like eating or dressing.

4. Behavioral Support and Counseling

- **Description:** Emotional and behavioral interventions for students experiencing challenges.
- **Services Provided:** Therapy sessions aimed at managing emotions, developing coping strategies, and improving self-regulation without needing an official IEP.

5. Social Skills Development

- **Description:** Programs focused on improving peer interactions and social communication.



- **Services Provided:** Activities, group interactions, and structured play sessions designed to teach children appropriate social behavior for example, turn-taking, and empathy.

6. Inclusive Classroom Settings

- **Description:** A learning environment where children with special needs are integrated into general classroom activities.
- **Services Provided:** Teachers use inclusive practices such as co-teaching, differentiated instruction, and peer support to ensure all students can participate and learn together.

7. Assistive Technology

- **Description:** Tools and technologies to support learning and communication for children with special needs.
- **Services Provided:** Access to devices such as communication boards, speech-generating apps, and adaptive learning software to help students overcome challenges in the classroom.

8. Enrichment Programs

- **Description:** Programs designed to engage children with special needs in arts, music, sports, and other creative activities.
- **Services Provided:** Inclusive after-school programs, art therapy, music therapy, and recreational activities aimed at developing motor skills, self-expression, and creativity.

9. Family Support and Training

- **Description:** Workshops and resources provided to families of children with special needs to help support their child's learning and development.
- **Services Provided:** Parent education sessions, behavioral workshops, and guidance on how to create a supportive home learning environment.

10. Physical Therapy

- **Description:** Support for children to improve mobility, strength, and coordination.
