



Miles Jones Foundation Educational Field Trip Itinerary

8:00 AM - Arrival & Check-In

- Students arrive at the Miles Jones Foundation, located at 1014 Starr Ave, Toledo, Ohio 43605.
- Roll call and group assignments are made.
- Quick briefing on the day's schedule, expectations, and safety guidelines.

8:30 AM - Departure

- Board buses and begin the trip to field trip destination.
- Educational pre-activity on the bus (e.g., reading materials or a short video related to the destination).

9:30 AM - Arrival at Field Trip Destination

- Students disembark and gather at the entrance.
- Welcome and orientation by destination staff, introduction to the key educational points of the visit.

10:00 AM - Guided Tour

- Guided exploration of field trip destination, focusing on topics relevant to classroom learning.
- Interactive sessions where students can ask questions and engage in discussions.

11:30 AM - Hands-On Activity

- Students participate in a hands-on learning activity or workshop.
 - Example: Science experiments, historical reenactments, art projects, etc.

12:30 PM - Lunch Break

- Lunch at the facility's cafeteria or picnic area.
- Opportunity for students to socialize and unwind in a structured environment.

1:15 PM - Exploration Time



- Free exploration in small groups with assigned chaperones.
 - Example: Visit different sections of the museum, explore the nature reserve, or take part in additional educational exhibits.

2:15 PM - Reflection Activity

- Group discussion on what was learned during the trip.
- Journaling or filling out a worksheet related to key lessons from the day.

3:00 PM - Departure

- Board buses and begin the return journey to the Miles Jones Foundation.
- Post-trip activity on the bus (e.g., trivia quiz, reflection discussion).

4:00 PM - Arrival Back at the Foundation

- Students return to 1014 Starr Ave.
- Final check-in and dismissal.
